SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

1. Art Specifications:

 Medium: Any medium is welcome media (marker, crayon, paint, collage, textiles, etc.), but please consider that posters will need to be reproduced in high glossy print form.

- Size: Designs must be at least 8.5 x 11in paper size (letter size) and have a PORTRAIT (Vertical) orientation. Larger posters will be accepted, up to 22 x 28in
- Digital scans or photo submissions must be high-quality (minimum 300 DPI for digital submissions).

2. Deadline:

Entries must be received by February 7th at 3pm.
